Direct:

- Current Members to the signing in tables in the Hall.
- Visitors to be directed to visitors table to pay £2 fee and be given further information about the u3a.
- New members to be directed to the new members' table, then to the Group Co-ordinator in the entrance if they wish.

Support for Members with Disabilities:

- Please keep an eye out for any members arriving with mobility difficulties:
- Open the double "fire exit" doors if this would enable them to access the building more easily
- Either escort them into the church and offer them a seat on the reserved front pew or ask if they need help from you to find a seat in the main hall or Guild Room.
- An accessible toilet is situated on the right of the corridor leading to the Guild Room
- There are also accessible toilets at the back of the main church
- A Hearing Loop facility is accessible in the church
- Two wheelchairs are available for use at the back of the church - see Karen or the caretaker for access to these

Remind people that tea/coffee is now served in the Guild Room.

Encourage people to go into the Church when the meeting is due to begin.
